

### Description

<b>Specificity</b>	Reacts with the heavy and light chains of rat IgG and IgM
<b>Source</b>	Pooled antisera from goats hyperimmunized with rat IgG and IgM
<b>Cross Adsorption</b>	Mouse immunoglobulins and pooled sera; may react with immunoglobulins from other species
<b>Purification</b>	Affinity chromatography on pooled rat Ig covalently linked to agarose

<b>ELISA</b>	AP conjugate	1:2,000 – 1:4,000
	HRP conjugate	1:4,000 – 1:8,000
	BIOT conjugate	1:5,000 – 1:20,000
<b>FLISA</b>	FITC, TRITC, TXRD, and AF555 conjugates	1:100 – 1:400
	PE, APC, and AF647 conjugates	≤ 1 µg/mL
<b>Flow Cytometry</b>	FITC and BIOT conjugates	≤ 1 µg/10 <sup>6</sup> cells
	PE and APC conjugates	≤ 0.1 µg/10 <sup>6</sup> cells
	For flow cytometry, the suggested use of these reagents is in a final volume of 100 µL

## Handling and Storage

- The purified (UNLB) antibody is supplied as 1.0 mg purified immunoglobulin in 1.0 mL of borate buffered saline, pH 8.2. *No preservatives or amine-containing buffer salts added.* Store at 2-8°C.
- The fluorescein (FITC), rhodamine (TRITC), Texas Red® (TXRD), Alexa Fluor® 555 (AF555), and Alexa Fluor® 647 (AF647) conjugates are supplied as 1.0 mg in 1.0 mL of PBS/NaN<sub>3</sub>. Store at 2-8°C.
- The alkaline phosphatase (AP) conjugate is supplied as 1.0 mL in a stock solution of 50 mM Tris/1 mM MgCl<sub>2</sub>/50% glycerol, pH 8.0, containing NaN<sub>3</sub> as preservative. Store at 2-8°C or long-term at -20°C.
- The horseradish peroxidase (HRP) conjugate is supplied as 1.0 mL in a stock solution of 50% glycerol/50% PBS, pH 7.4. No preservative added. Store at 2-8°C or long-term at -20°C.
- The biotin (BIOT) conjugate is supplied as 1.0 mg in 2.0 mL of PBS/NaN<sub>3</sub>. Store at 2-8°C.
- The R-phycoerythrin (PE) and allophycocyanin (APC) conjugates are supplied as 0.5 mg in 1.0 mL or 0.25 mg in 0.5 mL of PBS/NaN<sub>3</sub> and a stabilizing agent. Store at 2-8°C. **Do not freeze!**
- Protect fluorochrome-conjugated forms from light. Reagents are stable for the period shown on the label if stored as directed.
