


# Goat F(ab')<sub>2</sub> Anti-Rabbit IgG(H+L), Mouse/Human ads

Dilution of Goat F(ab')2 Anti-Rabbit IgG(H+L), Mouse/Human ads-UNLB

ELISA plate was coated with purified rabbit IgG and IgM, mouse IgG, IgM, and IgA, and human IgG, IgM, and IgA. Immunoglobulins were detected with serially diluted Goat F(ab')2 Anti-Rabbit IgG(H+L), Mouse/Human ads-UNLB (SB Cat. No. 4052-01) followed Swine Anti-Goat IgG(H+L), Human/Rat/Mouse SP ads-HRP (SB Cat. No. 6300-05).

## **Description**

**Specificity** Reacts with the heavy and light chains of rabbit IgG and the light chains of rabbit IgM **Source** Pepsin digest of Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG(H+L), Mouse/Human ads (SB Cat. No. 4050)

Cross Adsorption Mouse and human immunoglobulins and pooled sera; may react with immunoglobulins from other species

# **Handling and Storage**

- The purified (UNLB) antibody is supplied as 0.5 mg purified immunoglobulin in 1.0 mL of borate buffered saline, pH 8.2. No preservatives or amine-containing buffer salts added. Store at 2-8°C.
- The fluorescein (FITC), Alexa Fluor® 555 (AF555), and Alexa Fluor® 647 (AF647) conjugates are supplied as 0.5 mg in 1.0 mL of PBS/NaN<sub>3</sub>. Store at 2-8°C.
- The alkaline phosphatase (AP) conjugate is supplied as 1.0 mL in a stock solution of 50 mM Tris/1 mM MgCl<sub>2</sub>/50% glycerol, pH 8.0, containing NaN<sub>3</sub> as preservative. Store at 2-8°C or long-term at -20°C.
- The horseradish peroxidase (HRP) conjugate is supplied as 1.0 mL in a stock solution of 50% glycerol/50% PBS, pH 7.4. No preservative added. Store at 2-8°C or long-term at -20°C.
- The biotin (BIOT) conjugate is supplied as 0.5 mg in 1.0 mL of PBS/NaN<sub>3</sub>. Store at 2-8°C.
- The R-phycoerythrin (PE) conjugate is supplied as 0.25 mg in 1.0 mL of PBS/NaN<sub>3</sub> and a stabilizing agent. Store at 2-8°C. **Do not**
- Protect fluorochrome-conjugated forms from light. Reagents are stable for the period shown on the label if stored as directed.
