

Description

Chicken Bu-1b, a product of the Bu-1^b allele, is expressed on the cell surface as a disulfide-linked homodimer. In 10-week-old H.B15 and H.B2 chickens, Bu-1 is found on 85-90% of bursal cells, 2-8% of thymocytes, 15-27% of spleen cells, and 2-18% of peripheral blood cells. It is also expressed on subsets of macrophages and monocytes but not on granulocytes, erythrocytes, or thrombocytes. In chickens heterozygous for the Bu-1 alleles (Bu-1^{a/b}), Bu-1a does not exhibit allelic exclusion. The monoclonal antibody 5-11G2 reacts with lymphoid cells from CHA and H.B14Ab strains but does not react with cells from H.B14Aa.

Working Dilutions

 $\begin{array}{ll} \textbf{Flow Cytometry} & \text{Purified (UNLB) antibody} & \leq 1 \ \mu\text{g}/10^6 \ \text{cells} \\ & \text{FITC and BIOT conjugates} & \leq 1 \ \mu\text{g}/10^6 \ \text{cells} \\ & \text{PE conjugates} & \leq 0.2 \ \mu\text{g}/10^6 \ \text{cells} \\ \end{array}$

For flow cytometry, the suggested use of these reagents is in a final volume of 100 μL

Other Applications Since applications vary, you should determine the optimum working dilution for the product that is appropriate for your specific need.

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Handling and Storage

- The purified (UNLB) antibody is supplied as 0.5 mg of purified immunoglobulin in 1.0 mL of borate buffered saline, pH 8.2. No
 preservatives or amine-containing buffer salts added. Store at 2-8°C.
- The fluorescein (FITC) conjugate is supplied as 0.5 mg in 1.0 mL of PBS/NaN₃. Store at 2-8°C.
- The biotin (BIOT) conjugate is supplied as 0.5 mg in 1.0 mL of PBS/NaN₃. Store at 2-8°C.
- The R-phycoerythrin (PE) conjugate is supplied as 0.1 mg in 1.0 mL of PBS/NaN₃ and a stabilizing agent. Store at 2-8°C. Do not freeze!
- Protect fluorochrome-conjugated forms from light. Reagents are stable for the period shown on the label if stored as directed.
